The German Society of Charlotte (Alemannia Inc.) and The German Language and Culture Foundation Support Providence's German Program

Nearly 300 German speaking companies have their American headquarters in Charlotte, and it is no surprise that the German community here is growing. This year, two German organizations are generously extending their help to the Providence High School German program. In February, Alemannia Inc. provided the school with a generous grant of \$500, and Brigitte Hartenstein, President of The German Language and Culture Foundation, recently offered two donations, of \$1,500 and \$5,000 respectively.

Frau Christina Humphrey, a German teacher at Providence High School, expressed her appreciation to both organizations, planning to use the first two grants to purchase new textbooks for the growing AP German classes and continue to support Deutsch Klub and other language programs. The \$5,000 grant will be divided to fund the flights of ten Providence students participating in the GAAP exchange program with students in Germany. With nearly 400 students in Providence High School's German department, this money will surely be well spent.
